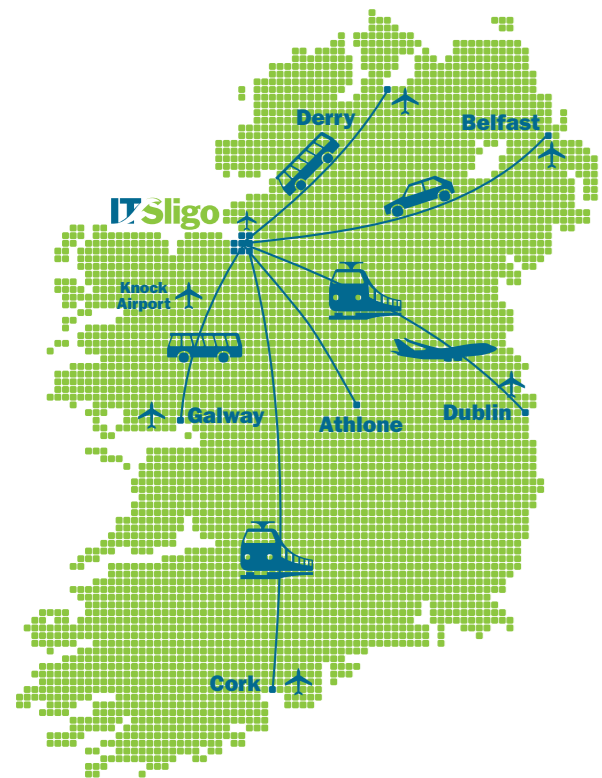


About Sligo

- The campus is centrally located in Sligo and is well serviced by public transport.
- Campus buildings comprise 40,000m² situated on a 70 acre edge of town parkland location.
- The most recent developments include a new Student Centre and state of the art Library/Learning Resource Centre that provides students with a dynamic focus for learning and study.
- Sports Facilities include the Knocknarea Arena, a 1,500m² multipurpose sports arena equipped for a range of indoor sports including football and basketball. We also have International standard outdoor athletics track; floodlit soccer and Gaelic pitches and leisure and gym facilities available to all staff, students and conference visitors on campus.
- Student Accommodation: there are 2,100 bed spaces provided within Sligo City exclusively for students.
- We provide spaces for 950 vehicles on campus with visitor, pay and display, and free parking.
